DEBBIE- I'm gonna kiss Donald Duck goodbye! *SMACK*





A large amount of people are buying knives. There are two main things
a person should look for when buying a knife. The first thing to look for is a
high quality blade. The second thing to look for are the safety features
available.

To begin with, a high quality blade should be able to bend a small amount. If it is not flexible, it will crack. It is also important to remember that if it is too flexible the metal in the blade is probably of low quality.


The safety features are important to protect you from accidental cuts.

Pocket knives, for instances, have a safety lock which keeps the blade
from snapping back. Some knives are stiff and that's fine, but not always a good
buy. Some knives will just snap back with the slightest amount of pressure.

All of these things are important to remember when buying a knife.




